SCHOOL EVENTS

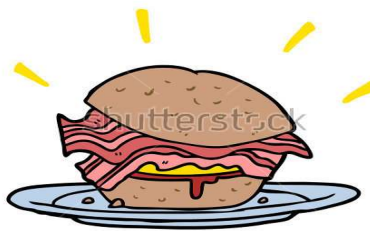
We have a number of events coming up in school:
